

13. READING THE BIBLE

This topic provides an opportunity to read through the Bible. If the entire Bible cannot be read, the group may concentrate on a section of the Old Testament such as Genesis, Exodus, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1–2 Samuel, 1–2 Kings, and the New Testament.
